Description of corner evidence found:

Found no trace of record post. Falls in road. Found down 16" pine, scribed "1/4S B". Measured S24°E, 81.2 ft.

Corner falls on west edge of road.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 2 1/2" X 30" galvanized pipe and brass cap marked: Set pipe 15" in the ground and mound of stone around to cap.

From which by magnetic declination of N20°E: A 16" poine bears S54°E, 106.2 ft. scribed 1/4S7 BT. A

12" pine bears S62°W, 11.2 ft. scribed 1/4S12 BT. Painted blazes red and 6" red band around. Placed 54-3s, 54-4s and brass washers stamped PLS 1051 on BTs. Palced 54-2 and 54-4 on steel fence post 5' south of the corner.
