

History of original corner establishment: Original survey by contract in 1883

The original notes state;

Run N89°54'E between sections 7 and 8 39.84 ch. set basalt stone 14x8m7 ins. 10" in ground marked ton north face

A pine 18" in dia bears N338 12 1ks dist marked # BT A pine 26" in dia bears S62°E76 lks Dist marked #BT

Found the stone marked.

A pine 22" in die beers N33°E 12 1ks dist.

A pine 30" in dia bears 362°E 76 lks dist marked & BT.

original location of this corner

At the position of the stone I set a 2" galvanised pipe 30" long with bronze eap on top and a 8" plat welded to bottom. I dug a hole Approx 18" deep and backfilled with stone and soil and raised a stone monument and placed the marked stone by the pipe.

I stamped the disk

R35E 37 From the carner the original bearing trees are; S18 A pine 22" in dia bears N33°E 12 lks. dist. A pine 30" in dia bears 862°E 76 lks dist. ORE LIC 381 1969 I placed a steel fence post at the corner with USFS sign

54-4 and a Mational Forest Boundary sign indication National Forest land to the North. I also placed USFS bearing tree signs

on the two bearing trees.

History of original corner establishment: Original corner set in 1982 by Rufus S. Moore under government contract number 451.

Surveyor General notes state;

Set basalt stone 14x8x7, 10 inches in the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ section c corner marked 4 on N face from which

A pine 18 ins in dia bears W 33 E 12 1ks dist, marked ¼ SBT A pine 26 ins dia. bears S 62 E 76 1ks dist. marked ¼ SBT Corner remonumented in August 1969

County Surveyor Records state;

At the position of the stone I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30 in long with pronze cap on top; and a 8" plate welded to bottom. I dug hole approx. 18" deep and backfilled with stone and soil and raised a tone mound and placed the marked stone by the pipe From the corner the original bearing trees are;

A pine 22" in diameter bears N 33 E 12 1ks. dist.

A pine 30" in diamter bears \$ 62 E 76 1ks dist.

I placed a steel fence plst at the corner with USFS sign 54-4 and a National forest sign indicating National forest land to the North. I also placed USFS Bearing Tree signs on the two bearing trees;

I found a brass cap marked as shown below, with original stone alongside. A 22" pine, dead and standing bears N 33 E, 8.6 feet, scribes visible. A pine 30 in diameter bears S 62 E 50 feet, dead and down, scribes visible.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: I placed 54-4 signs on all original trees. New BT Trees; From the brass cap

A 14" Douglas fir bears N 4 E 28.3 feet marked 4 S 7 BT, with a brass washer stamped OPLS 991 at the BT blaze.

A 15" Douglas Fir bears \$ 61 E 37.4 feet, marked 4 S 18 BT, with a brass washer stamped OPLS 991 at the BT blaze.

I placed USFS bearing tree signs and 54-4 signs at each new bearing tree.

I used a magnetic compass with 18 degree East declination set in , and a steel tape. Distance taken to the center of the trees.
