Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the location of the corner I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30% long with a bronze cap on top and an 8" plate welded to bottom. The pipe is set 18" deep and back filled with stone and soil and raised a stone monument around the pipe.

From the pipe the original bearing trees are. A 22" snag at \$52°W at 14 lks distance. At \$147°E the bearing tree has fallen. I set new bearing trees as follows. A far 8E in diam bears \$32°W 31 feet dist marked \$587
