

A pine 18" in diam bars N34°E 155 lks dist. marked T3S R35ES11BT A pine 16" in diam bears N43°W 101 lks dist marked T3S R35ES10BT. A pine 15" in daim bears \$\$60°W 255 lks dist marked T3S R35ES15BT. A pine 15" in diam bears \$80°E320 lks dist marked T3S R35ES14BT.

Description of corner evid

At record distances from the corner I found all of the trees with signs of scribing and blazes.



nd accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

At the position of the corner I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long and with bronze cap on top and 8" plate welded to bottom. The pine is set on rock at 6 inch depth and raised a stone monument around the pipe.

I stamped the disk

T3S R35E 510| 511 S15 S14 ORE LIC 381 1969

From the corner monument the original bearing trees are; A pine 19" in diam bears N45°W 101 lks dist. (with blaze scar) A pine 20" in diam bears N34°E 155 lks dist. marked T3S R35E SIIBT.

A pine 16" in diam bears S80°E 320 lks dist marked T3S R35E S14BT. A pine 20" in diam bears S\$0°W 255 lks dist with blaze scar.

I set a steel fence post at the corner with USFS sign 54-4 attached. Bearing tree signs were placed on the bearing trees facing the corner.
