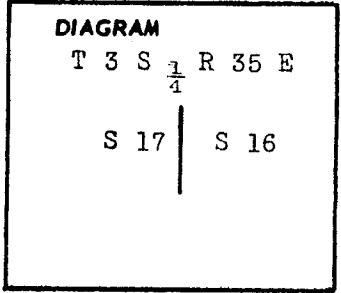


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established in 1882 by Rufus S. Moore under General Land Office contract no. 451. Surveyor General Notes State;



Set basalt stone 13"x7"x6", 9 inches in the ground for the $\frac{1}{4}$ section corner, 300 feet above the creek, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on the west face, from which

A pine 6 inches in diameter bears N 22 E 28 links, distant marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

A fir 8" in diameter bears S 60 W 56 links distant, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

No remonumentation found in the county record.

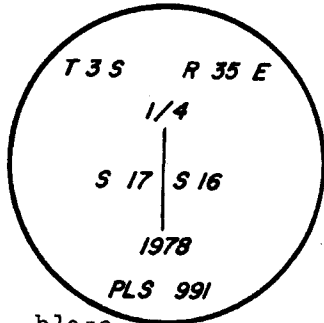
Description of corner evidence found:

Found NE. BT. stump, rotted, with blaze lying alongside with scribes visible.

Found SW. BT. stump, scar visible, did not open.

I did not find the stone.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" galvanized iron pipe with brass cap 18" in the ground and raised a mound of stone at the record distances and bearings from the BTs. from which New BTs.



A pine 12" in diameter bears N 7 W a distance of 24.6 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 17 BT.

A fir 10" in diameter bears S 30 E a distance of 43.0 feet, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 16 BT.

I placed a nail and a brass washer marked O.P.L.S. 991 at the BT. blaze

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass with 20 degrees East declination set into the compass.

I set a steel fence post with a sign 4.0 feet south of the corner.
