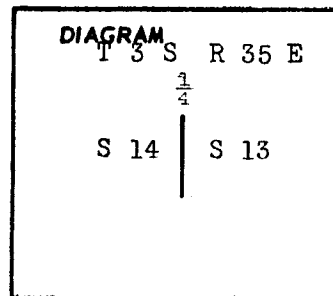


**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

**History of original corner establishment:** Corner established in 1882 by Rufus S. Moore under General Land Office contract no. 451. Surveyor General Notes state; Set a basalt stone 14"x10"x7", 10 inches in the ground for  $\frac{1}{4}$  section corner on top of ridge slope SW, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on West face 300 feet above dry gulch, from which;



A pine, 20" in diameter bears N 47 E, 83 links distant, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ S BT.

A pine, 40" in diameter bears N 45 W, 7 links distant, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S BT.

**Description of corner evidence found:**

Found stone of called size marked  $\frac{1}{4}$

Found NW BT. dead and down, scribes visible. BT at called distance and bearing.

Found NE BT. stump, rotted at called bearing and distance, no scribes visible.

**Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the**

**original location of this corner** I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" galvanized iron pipe 24" in the ground where the marked stone lay, and raised a mound of stone from which New BTS

A pine 12" in diameter bears N 81 W, a distance of 66.5 feet, Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ S 14 BT.

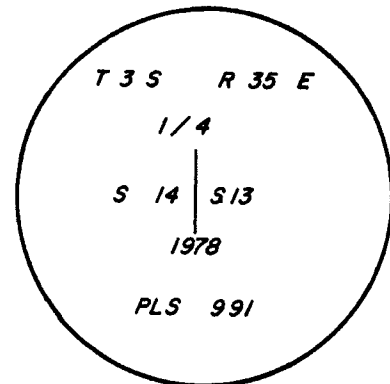
A pine 10" in diameter Bears N 34 E a distance of 62.8 feet Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ S 13 BT

I placed a nail and a brass washer marked O.P.L.S 991 at the BT. Blaze.

I used a steel tape and a magnetic compass with 20 degrees East declination set into the compass.

I set a steel fence post with sign 5.0 feet North of corner.

Note; I buried the stone to the north of the corner.
