Did not find post.


Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" galvanized iron pipe with brass cap 24" in the ground at the record distances and bearings from the BTs., from which;

New BTs.

A fir 10" in diameter bears S 35 W a distance of 21.0 feet marked  $\frac{1}{4}\text{S}$  21 BT.

A fir 10" in diameter bears N 67 W a distance of 22.5 feet marked  $\frac{1}{4}\text{S}$  16 BT.

I placed a nail and a brass washer marked O.P.L.S. 991 at the BT. blaze.



I used a steel tape and a magnetic compass with 20 degrees East declination set into the compass.

I set a steel post with a sign 5.0 feet East of the corner.
