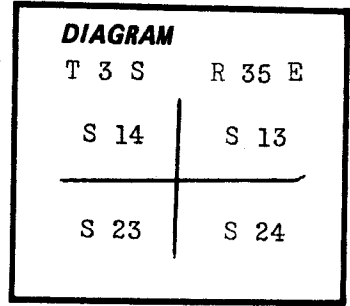


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner established in 1882 by Rufus S. Moore under General Land Office contract no. 451.



SURVEYORS GENERAL RECORD STATES

Set basalt stone 12 x 12 x 5 for cor. to sects. 13-14-23-24, marked with 3 notches on S. and 1 notch on E. edges, raised mound of stone along side.

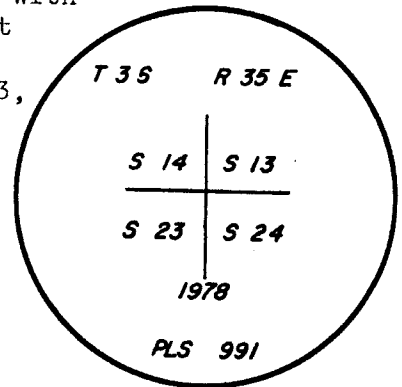
No restoration appears in the county records.

Description of corner evidence found:

None

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: I set a 2 1/2" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with brass cap 20" in the ground by a double proportion measurement from the NW section corner to the North being the W 1/4 section corner of section 14, from the S 1/4 section corner of Section 13, from the E 1/4 section corner of Section 23, from the NW section corner of section 23, from which New BTS.



A pine 12" in diameter bears N 39 W a distance of 83.7 feet, marked T 3 S R 35 E S 14 BT.

A fir 22" in diameter bears S 12 E a distance of 30.0 feet, marked T 3 S R 35 E S 24 BT

A pine 22" in diameter bears S 29 W a distance of 27.3 feet, Marked T 3 S R 35 E S 23 BT

No tree available in the NE quadrant.

I placed a nail and a brass washer marked O.P.L.S. 991 at the BT. blaze.

I set a steel fence post 5.0 feet West of the corner.

I used a steel tape and a magnetic compass with 20 degrees East declination set into the compass.
