Description of corner evidence found:

Found 8" pine dead, scribes visible at N 70 W. Found evidence of stump at the position of the SE. bearing tree. I did not find the stone.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: I set a $2\frac{1}{2}x30$ inch galvanized iron pipe with brass cap marked as shown right, 25 inches in the ground, at the record bearing and distance from the NW. bearing tree, and raised; a mound of stone, from which New BT.S

A 8 " diameter fir bears S 36 E, 5.9 feet distant, market $\frac{1}{4}$ S 24 BT.

A 10 diameter fir beers N 83 W, 3.4 feet distant, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 23 BT.

I placed a nail and a brass washer marked O.P.L.S 991 at the BT. Blaze.

I used a steel tape and a magnetic compass with 20 degrees East declinaton set into the compass.

I set a steel post with a sign 4.0 feet north of corner.
