
History of original corner establishments

Original survey by General Land Office (Contract Survey) 1882. The Original notes state; Set a Basalt stone 18x12x5 ins., 12 ins. in the ground for cor to section 23,24,25,26. from which; A pine 48" in diam bears 533°W 159 lks dist. marked T3S R35E S26BT and raised a mound of stone along side.

Description of somer evidence found:

A pine 48" in diam bears 333°W 159 lks dist.



Description of manument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this normer

At the position of the corner I set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long and with a 8" plate welded to bottom and a bronze cap on top of the pipe. The pipe is set Approx. 10" deep and a mound of stone raised around the pipe.

I stamped the disk

At the position of he corner the original bearing tree is;

A pine 48" in diam bears S33°W 159 lks dist.

I also established the following new bearing frees.

A pine 26" in diam bears N80°W 67.8 ft. marked T3S R35E S23BT.

A pine 16" in diam bears N35°E 344Ft. dist marked T3S R35E S24BT; A pine 24" in diam bears S40°E 81 ft. dist marked T3S R35E S25BT.

I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached. USFS Bearing tree signs were placed on the bearing trees shoulder high facing the corner.

(Distance from respective bearing trees measured from center of trees and marked with a scribe.)
