A pine $14^{\rm H}$ in diam bears S87°W 221 lks dist marked $\frac{1}{4}$ SBT.

Both bearing trees were found. At S87°W a rotten slab was found with scribe marks visible. At N29°W A pine stump was found with BT scribe visible.



Description of monum ent and accessories I established to perpetuate the original facation of this corner

Set a 2" galvanized pipe 30" long 16" in the ground with bronze cap on top and 8" plate welded to bottom. Back filled the hole with stone and tamped soil and raised a stone monument. The marked stone was placed along side the pipe.

I marked the disk.

From the corner the original trees are; A pine stump bears N29°W 314 lks dist. A rotten slab bears S87°W approx 221 lks dist.

I also established two new bearing trees;

A fir 28" in diam bears N13°E 245 feet marked \$SBT A 15" pine bears N49°W 150 feet marked \$BT (Trees marked with scribe and measurements to BT scribe on the trees.) I set a steel fence post with USFS sign 54-4 attached. USFS bearing tree sign were placed on both old and

new bearing trees facing the corner.
