CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John A. Hurlburt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, under GLO Contract No. 201 dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General records state:

Set basalt stone 20 x 15 x 12 - 10 ins. in ground and made stone mound 2 ft. high for Cor. to Sec. 4, 5, 8, and 9.

Description of corner evidence found:

A basalt stone 20" x 15" x 12" lying partially buried on south edge of stone mound with 4 notches on east side and 5 notches on south side. Initially thought stone may have been disturbed as GLO notes state that stone was buried 10 inches in ground. Found bedrock at 6 inch depth and accept position of stone.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Chisel "X" 1 inch deep in bedrock to mark corner position. Paint "X" red. Place original stone in it's found position on top of the chiseled "X". Build stone mound around original stone. Set galvanized steel post with 54-9 sign 6' north.

From which:

A Ponderosa Pine, 10" in diameter, bears N12°E, 80.8' scribed X BT.
A Ponderosa Pine, 12" in diameter, bears S13°E, 60.6' scribed T3S R36E S9 BT.
A Ponderosa Pine, 14" in diameter, bears S24°W, 54.7' scribed T3S R36E S8 BT.
A Ponderosa Pine, 16" in diameter, bears N23°W, 74.2' scribed T3S R36E S5 BT.

New bearing trees have 54-3 and 54-9 signs attached, a brass washer stamped PLS 2672 nailed between the B and T on the lower face, and a 6" red painted band. Bearing tree faces are also painted red. The distance is measured to a 30d spike in the right side center of the bearing trees.
