Description of corner evidence found:

A Ponderosa Pine to North, 16" in diameter, with partially visible scribing on burnt upper face and BT scribed on lower face with chaining notch (original bearing tree). A stumphole of indeterminante size at record bearing and distance to SW. No evidence of original post. Area burned by Spring Fire in 2005.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At record bearing and distance from the original bearing tree (North, 33 Lks.), I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a standard USFS 3 1/4" diameter aluminum cap marked as shown in the corner diagram 25" in the ground in a stone mound. Set galvanized steel post with 54-9 sign 5' to West.

From which:

A Ponderosa Pine 14" in diameter bears S42°E, 33.3' scribed 1/4 S9 BT.

A Ponderosa Pine 15" in diameter bears S57'W, 47.8' scribed 1/4 S9 BT.

A Ponderosa Pine 9" in diameter bears N68'W, 29.4' scribed X BT.

New bearing trees have 54-3 and 54-9 signs attached, a brass washer stamped PLS 2672 nailed between the B and T on the lower face, and a 6" red painted band. Bearing tree faces are also painted red. The distance is measured to a 60d spike in the right side center of the bearing trees. The original bearing tree has 54-3 and 54-9 signs attached and a 6" red painted band.
