
## **UNION COUNTY** CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John H. Hurlburt under GLO Contract Number 201, dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General record states: Post 4 inches square in ground in. for 1/4 Sec. Cor. from

A 24 inch diameter Pine bears North, 127 Lks. A 36 inch diameter Pine bears S16°E, 220 Lks.



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument. Area had been logged and burned.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At the proportionate position, determined by survey I 2½"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 24 inches in the ground, I set from which:


New Bearing Trees;
A 16 inch diameter Ponderosa pine bears N84°E, 56.13 feet marked 1/4 S2 BT
A 14 inch diameter Ponderosa pine bears S53°W, 112.57 feet marked 1/4 S11 BT
A 15 inch diameter Ponderosa pine bears West, 115.07 feet marked XX BT
A 19 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N20°W, 115.44 feet marked X BT

Raised a mound of stone with a three foot base to the top of the cap. Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet East. with a 54-9 sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on July 13, 1992.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
