




Duane Griffith, PLS 644, re-established this corner by proportion July 14, 1992. He set a 2 ½" x 30" aluminum cap, 28 inches in the ground, with 4 references.

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with aluminum cap bearing N15°E, 24.65 feet. A 26" diameter cottonwood bearing S53°E, 100.53 feet. A 28" diameter cottonwood bearing 54°W, 93.40 feet. A 5/8" x 30" rebar with aluminum cap bearing N80°W, 29.91 feet.
