

At the proportionate position, determined by survey, I 2½"x30" aluminum cap marked as shown, 10 inches below the ground surface, from which;



 A 5/8x30 inch rebar with an aluminum cap bears N43°E, 6.22 feet marked T3S R36E % S14 RM 6.22 1992 OPLS 644.
 A 5/8x30 inch rebar with an aluminum cap bears S30°E, 6.09 feet marked T3S R36E % S14 RM 6.09 1992 OPLS 644.
 A 5/8x30 inch rebar with an aluminum cap bears S50°W, 6.17 feet marked T3S R36E % S15 RM 6.17 1092 OPLS 644
- 5/8x30 inch rebar with an aluminum cap bears S50°W, 6.17 feet marked T3S R36E % S15 RM 6.17 1992 OPLS 644.
 5/8x30 inch rebar with an aluminum cap bears N45°W, 5.90 feet marked T3S R36E % S15 RM 5.90 1992 OPLS 644.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet South with a 54-9 sign attached.



History of original corner establishment:

Corner was originally set under GLO Contract Number 201, dated August 5, 1873 by John Hurlburt. He set a stone of 18" \times 8" \times 6" marked $\frac{1}{4}$ in a mound of stone for the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to Sections 15 and 14.




Duane Griffith perpetuated the corner by proportion July 14, 1992, with 2 ½" x 30" aluminum cap 10 inches below ground and four references:
