
UNION COUNTY CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John H. Hurlburt under GLO Contract Number 201, dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General record states:
Set post 4 ft. long, 4 in. square, 24 in. in ground for cor. to Secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24, from which;



A Pine 15 in. diam. bears N77°E, 158 lks. dist. A Pine 40 in. diam. bears S71°E, 146 lks. dist. A Willow 4 in. diam. bears S85°W, 73 lks. dist. A Pine 12 in. diam. bears N45°W, 249 lks. dist.

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records. Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner post. Found a 20+" Ponderosa Pine stump N77°E, 158 lks, dead, down, blaze visibTe, no scribes visible.

This tree and the SE BT were found by Mitchell in 1976. Mitchel found scribes on this NE BT, they are now weathered away.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At record bearing and distance as determined from found bearing tree, I set a 2½"x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground, from which;
New Bearing Trees or objects;
A 5/8" X 30" rebar with alum.cap bears N51°E, 25.45',mk'd T3S R36E S13 RM
25.45 1992 OPLS 644.
A 5/8" X 30" rebar with alum.cap bears S84°E, 306.76',mk'd T3S R36E S24 RM

A 5/8" X 30" rebar with alum.cap bears Noite, 25.45 ,mk'd 155 R50E 515 R5 25 45 1992 OPLS 644.
A 5/8" X 30" rebar with alum.cap bears S84°E, 306.76 ,mk'd T3S R36E S24 RM 306.76 1992 OPLS 644.
A 1" x 48" iron pipe bears S26°W, 6.15 feet mk'd OPLS 644.
A 28" Ponderosa pine bears N66°W, 213.11 feet, mk'd T3S R36E S14 BT Raised a small mound of stone around monument.
Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with Attention sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on July 3, 1992.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
