Description of corner evidence found:

A pine bearing N78°W 30" in diam was found. The scribe marks were visible on this tree. There was not any other evidence found.



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set 2" galvanized pipe 30" long and 18" in the ground with bronze cap on top and 8" plate welded to the bottom. The hole was back filled with stone and tamped earth and a stone monument was raised around the pipe.

I stamped the disk

T3S R35E R36E S24 S19 CRE LIC 381 1969

From the corner the original bearing tree is;
A pine 30" in diam bears N78°W 149 lks dist.
I set a new bearing tree; A pine 16" in diam bears S44°W 101 feet dist measured on the slope to BT on the tree. I marked the tree with a scribe \$SBT.
