
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At position determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 30 inches in the ground, from which;

New Bearing Trees; A 15 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S20°W, 30.00 feet marked CE 1/16 S21 BT A 12 inch diameter Douglas Fir bears S78°W, 29.33 feet marked X BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 2 ft. base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with Land Survey Monument sign attached.
