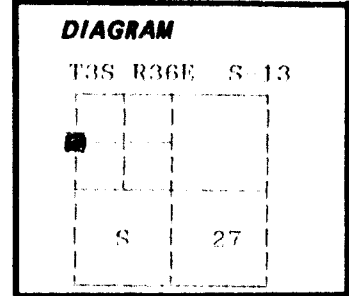


**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

New Bearing Trees;

A 21 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N25°W, 71.63 feet marked N1/16 S28 BT

NO OTHER TREES AVAILABLE

Raised a mound of stone around monument; 4 ft base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with Land Survey Monument sign attached.
