Description of corner evidence found:

Could find no evidence of original corner post. Found Ponderosa Pine 22 inches in diameter bearing N46^OW, 39 lks (25.74') with visible scribing in upper blaze. B.T. in Section 31 could not be found.

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: Measured record bearing and distance from found original BT to reestablish original corner position. At corner position set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" galvanized pipe with brass cap stamped: Set pipe 20" in ground with mound of stone to cap.

Bearing Trees:
