

original location of this corner: At corner position as determined by survey, I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 22 inches in the ground, from which:

A 17 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N39°E, 95.80 feet marked X BT A 30 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S6°E, 62.59 feet marked CW 1/16 S36 BT

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 4 ft. base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with land survey monument sign attached. $\label{eq:steel} % \begin{array}{c} \text{South with } \\ \text{South$
