
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

original location of this corner: At corner position as determined by survey, I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 20 inches in the ground, from which:

New BTs: A 12 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S30°E, 79.84 feet marked C¼ S36 BT A 12 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S84°W, 70.70 feet marked X BT


Raised a mound of stone around monument, 4 ft. base to top of cap.

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached bearing tree and land survey monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet South with land survey monument sign attached.
