
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by John A. Hurlburt under GLO contract number 201, dated August 5, 1873. Surveyor General record states:

Set pine post 4 ft. long 4 in. square 2 ft. in ground and made stone mound for cor to sec 31-32-5 and 6.

Corner found by Herman D. Gradon on GLO contract number 452, dated June 16, 1882. Sur General record states:
The old sec cor a post with 4 bearing trees bears W 15.83 chs dist.
I obliterate the marks on post referring to secs S of the line, also the marks in the bearing trees S of line.

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

## Description of corner evidence found:

Found no evidence of the original corner monument.

Found a stump hole N62°E, 78 lks.

Found a stump hole \$35°E, 58 lks.

Found a stump hole \$63°W, 18 lks.

Found a 20 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine N12°W, 5 lks, dead and down with scribes visible.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At record bearing and distance from the found original bearing trees, I set a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 27 inches in the ground, from which;

New Bearing Trees; A 16 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N75°E, 88.22 feet marked T3S R36E S32 BT A 8 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N41°W, 39.00 feet marked T3S R36E S31 BT

Painted a 6 inch red band around all BTs and attached Bearing Tree and Land Survey Monument signs.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet East with Land Survey Monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on October 2, 1989.
