
# LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

### History of original corner established:

Corner originally established by Odell and Gray under GLO contract 120, dated May 27, 1867. This contract only established the south line of Township 2 South by running the north boundary of Sections 1 through 6 of Township 3, South, Range 37 East. The record notes states: Township 3 South, Range 37 East West on north boundary of Sec. 4 80.00 Chains —"Set post corner for sections 4,5,32,33. Deposited marked stone and raised stone mound as per instruction.

John A Hurlbrt surveyed Section 32 under contract 201, dated August 5, 1873 and completed June 12, 1874. No mention of the monument was recorded.

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey record.



## Description of corner evidence found:

Found a dilapidated rock crib and remains of a barbed wire fence running north and west from said rock crib. Searched rock crib thoroughly but did not find evidence of marked stone. Using a single proportionate method along the range line between the southwest corner section 32 and the southeast corner of section 36 placed the rock crib 3—feet north and 16—feet westerly of the proportional solution. The physical evidence of the rock crib fence corner was held for the section corner.

#### Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

I set a 2-3/8 inch brass cap attached to a 1-inch by 30-inch iron pipe having 2 split legs, set 20—inches into the ground with a mound of stones to brass cap face. The brass cap was stamped as shown.

#### Accessories set:

**Section 33** - 5/8" by 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OREGON STATE PARKS" set in mound of stones bearing North 51'13'00" East, 15.70 feet from section corner monument.

Section 4 - 5/8" by 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OREGON STATE PARKS" set in mound of stones bearing South 84°32'40" East, 13.86 feet from section corner monument.

Section 5 – 5/8" by 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OREGON STATE PARKS" set in mound of stones bearing South 34°23'36" West, 9.25 feet from section corner monument.

Section 32 - 5/8" by 30" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OREGON STATE PARKS" set in mound of stones bearing North 63'36'40" West, 14.89 feet from section corner monument.
