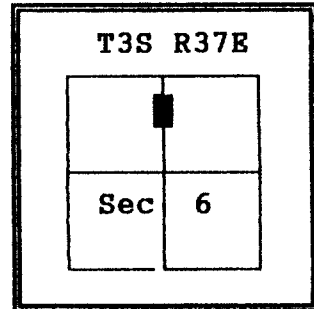


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by survey I set a 2-1/2" X 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 23 inches in the ground, from which;

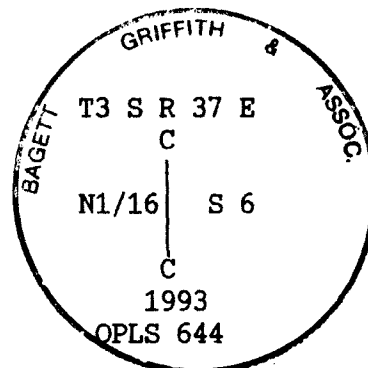
A 18 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S47°E, 198.4 feet, marked X BT

A 17 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N17°W, 108.87 feet, marked CN 1/16 S6 BT

Raised mound of stone 3 foot base to top cap.

Set a steel fence post approximately 3 feet north.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on May 30, 1993.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
