
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

At the position determined by survey I set a 2-1/2" X 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 24 inches in the ground, from which;

A 31 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N33°E, 105.5 feet marked NE BT

A 26 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N65°E, 107.08 feet marked C 1/4 S6 BT

A 5/8 X 30" rebar with plastic cap, bears West, 5.90 feet marked BGA SURVEY MARKER

A 20 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N12°W, 222.0 feet marked NW BT

Set a steel fence post approximately 6 feet west.
