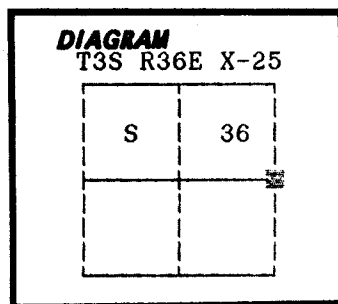


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment:

Corner originally established by William H. Odell under GLO contract number 120, dated May 27, 1867. Surveyor General record states:

Set 1/4 sec post cor
Deposited marked stone and raised stone mound as per instructions



No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Description of corner evidence found:

No evidence of the original corner was found. There are 4 fencelines in the immediate area of this corner, all of which have mounds of stone at the fenceposts.

Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the corner position determined by survey, I set a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 18 inches in the ground, from which:

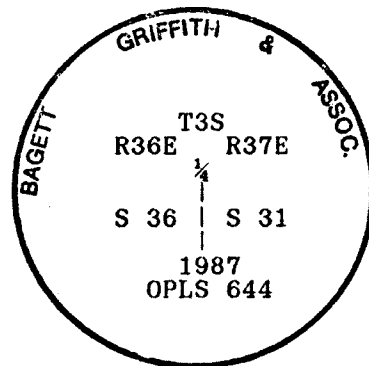
- New Bearing Trees and Objects;
- A 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap marked BGA SURVEY MARKER bears S49°E, 20.53 feet in a mound of stone.
- A 16 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S26°46'E, 407.56 feet marked 1/4 S36 BT (Bearing and distance taken with theodolite and EDM because of distance to BT)

Raised a mound of stone around monument, 5 ft. base to top of cap.

Set a steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with land survey monument sign attached.

I hereby certify that the above corner point was perpetuated as hereon described on November 11, 1987.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. (unless otherwise stated) I used 19° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven in the right side of the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 644 to the BT blaze.
