

CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

A monument reporting to be this corner was set by improper methods in 1941 by Morgan. His record reads:

Set center Sec 32 2" x 2" pine stake. 6" tree marked. Tree bears N30 $^\circ\text{W}$ 6.0'.



I found no subsequent record of monumentation in the Union County survey records.



DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the proper position computed per the 1973 Manual of instructions I set a 1" \times 24" iron rebar with a 2" aluminum cap flush with the surface of the ground. The cap was stamped as shown below.

I marked four bearing trees. Each bearing tree has a 1 1/2" brass washer fastened between the letters B and T with a 2" PK nail. The washer is stamped WTS and 56295 LS. Measurements were taken to the dent in the head of the nail with a Trimble 5601 electronic total station. Bearings are based on the survey control for County Survey No. 032–2004.

Ponderosa Pine bears NO9°34'26"W, 83.94', scribed A 10" Ponderosa Pine pears Nos 3- 23 ... 25 ... C1/4 S32 BT.
An 18" Pondersa Pine bears S42°36'43"E, 18.52', scribed C1/4 S32 BT.
An 11" Pondersa Pine bears S04°32'53"W, 34.39', scribed C1/4 S32 BT.
A 13" Pondersa Pine bears S68°01'04"W, 37.88', scribed C1/4 S32 BT.
