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

At the proper position computed per the 1973 Manual of instructions I set a 1" \times 24" iron rebar with a 2" aluminum cap flush with the surface of the ground. The cap was stamped as shown below.

I marked two bearing trees. Each bearing tree has a copper nail with a 1 1/8" head stamped WTS and 56295LS driven between the letters B & T. Measurements were taken to the dent in the head of the nail with a Trimble 5601 electronic total station. Bearings are based on the survey control for County Survey No. 032-2004.

An 18" Ponderosa Pine bears S77 $^{\circ}20'45"W$, 138.22', scribed S1/16 S31 BT. A 23" Pondersa Pine bears S48 $^{\circ}42'07"E$, 81.33', scribed S1/16 S32 BT.
