A 5/8" x 30" rebar with 1 ½" aluminum cap bears S53°W, a distance of 28.96 feet, marked UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR SW RP.

A 5/8" x 30" rebar with 1 ½" aluminum cap bears N44°W, a distance of 31.10 feet, marked UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR NW RP.
