CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by David Thompson under GLO Contract Number 103, dated 1863. Surveyor General states: "Set post for cor. to secs. 11, 12, 13, and 14 in mound of earth with charred stake, pits and trenches".


This corner was established at the physical intersection of Gekeler Lane and Pierce Road as this was the best available evidence of where the section corner was. Union County Road records Journal A, pages 30 and 44 both referenced this section corner as Point of Beginning for Pierce Road to the North and to the South.

Corner position was set as noted in October, 2012 by Union County Survey No. CS 034-2012.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Construction activities during the improving and widening of Pierce Road in 2011 allowed excavation of the road bed at the intersection of Pierce Road and Gekeler Lane. Survey evidence found consisted of an 18"x18"x6" smooth basalt stone 8" below roadway ballast on the physical centerline of Pierce Road and 6.2' south of the centerline of Gekeler Lane. This stone was not accepted as the Section corner as it is not of record, however there are numerous other surveys in the area calling for unmarked stones. These stones were often used to replace the posts, mounds, pits, and trenches set by the GLO. We do feel it has value as supporting evidence to the location of the corner set at the road intersection.
