
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with a 2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8"x30" iron pin set by survey number 6-73, bears South 82°09' West, a distance of 13.26 ft.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "NW RP" bears N  $29^{\circ}23$ 'W, a distance of 30.12 ft. (Pin is set in an existing North-South fence line.
