
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 5/8"x30" iron pin with a 2" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 30" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "SE RP" bears S 43°'E, a distance of 21.75 ft. (Pin is set in an existing East-West fence line.

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked "SW RP" bears S 47°W, a distance of 20.80 ft. (Pin is set in an existing East-West fence line.


