
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 5/8"X30" iron pin with 2½" aluminum cap marked as shown below, 29" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

An 14" diameter Douglas Fir bears North 59° East, a distance of 22.15 feet, marked C 1/4 S32 BT.

A 10" diameter Western Larch bears North 75° West, a distance of 55.80 feet, marked C 1/4 S32 BT.

An 10" diameter Western Larch bears South 77° East, a distance of 71.40 feet, marked X BT.

A 10" diameter Western Larch bears South 3° West, a distance of 95.10 feet, marked Y BT.

I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. The magnetic declination used was 18° East. The distance to the bearing trees is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 991 to the BT blaze.
