

A 16 inch Ponderosa Pine bears North 36° West, a distance of 72.60 feet, marked CE 1/16 S32 BT





I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of new accessories. The magnetic declination used was 18° East. The distance to the bearing tree is to a 50d spike driven on the right side of the tree at the root crown. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 991 to the BT blaze.
