No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County Survey records.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found ancient fence line and fence corner South 23.64 feet and West 9.0 feet from the proportioned position. I accepted the fence corner as best evidence considering the Old Book Survey, and that a fence was probably built on the corner.

An 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1" Aluminum Cap, bears South 19° West, 13.31 feet, marked SW RP

A 5/8"x30" iron pin with 1" Aluminum cap, bears North 69° West, 6.73 feet marked NW RP, set in an East West Fence.


