
TOWNSHIP 35 ,RANGE 38 & 39 E.

Set post corner to Sections 6, 7, 1 and 12, made mound of earth and drove charred stake as per instructions.

Monumented with 2 ½" Brass cap on 5/8" iron pin by Norm Paullus in Survey Number 43-84 at proportionate position, marked as shown below.

No record of subsequent monumentation found in Union County survey records.

Found 2 1/2" Brass cap 10" below grade in center of Anson Road,

An unrecorded 5/8" smooth rod bears North 20° East, a distance of 3.08 feet. (Used as an accessory to this corner)


