Description of corner evidence found:

Corner MODIFIED to refer to two townships only by Alonzo Gesner under GLO Contract No.683 dated June 07,1898, and his record states: Intersected west Bndy of Tp. 17.84 chs. south of Tps. 2 & 3 S which is a post 5 ins sq & 3 ft above ground mkd and witnesses as stated by the U.S.Surveyor General. I obliterated marks on the NE & SE faces of the post also obliterated marks on the bearing trees relating to Tps 2 & 3 SR41E.

The original corner post or accessories were not recovered in old burned area.

Note: A standing dead lodgepole pine 12 ins in diam. with a healed single blaze breast high on each of four sides (3" overgrowth) brs N10°E, 9.7 ft dist from reestablished township corner position...significance and origin unknown.

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

New bearing trees established: A spruce 11" diam brs N03 $^{\rm O}$ W, 7.6 ft dist mkd T2SR40ES36 BT. A spruce 10" diam brs S84 $^{\rm O}$ W, 15.0 ft dist mkd T3SR40ES1 BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1639 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and 6" band of red around each BT.

Compass declination 190 East.
