
History of original corner establishment:

Corner ESTABLISHED by W.B.Barr under GLO contract No.355, dated June 14, 1880.

Surveyor General records state:


Set stake 4 ft long 4 in diam 18 in ground for 1/4 Sec Corner, from which:

A tamarack 15 in diam bears $N25^{\circ}E$, 18 lks dist. A tamarack 6 in diam bears $S15^{\circ}W$, 40 lks dist.



Description of corner evidence found:

Searched 6 man-hours total on 8-19-87 and 8-19-88 in swampy blow down area dominated by rotten tree remains - corner post or accessories not found and corner declared lost.



Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

At proportioned position on line between NE & SE corners to Section l... Set $2\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap on 2"x 30" aluminum pipe 24" in ground to bedrock & surrounded with mound of earth & stone. Set 6' steel fence post alongside corner with sign 54-9 attached. Cap marked as shown in corner diagram.

New bearing trees established:

A lodgepole pine 10" diam brs $S71\frac{1}{2}^{0}W$, 6.0' dist mkd 1/4Sl BT. A spruce 12" diam brs Sll ^{0}W , 6.0' dist mkd 1/4Sl BT.

New bearing trees have a brass washer stamped PLS 1639 nailed to face of blaze. Attached signs 54-3 & 54-9 and painted face of blaze and 6" band of red around each BT.

Compass declination 190 East.
