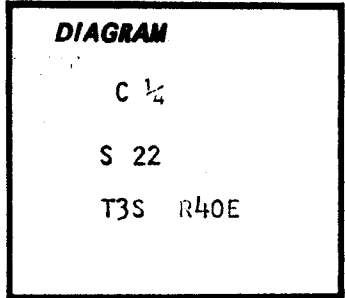


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

**History of original corner establishment:**

Corner originally established by J.L. Curtis, Union County Surveyor. I found no record of the original survey, but a survey done by L.L. Howland, Union County Surveyor, done in 1915 calls finding a marked stone set by Curtis. Survey number 64-78 by Duane I. Griffith, calls finding a 3/4 inch diameter pipe 2 feet below the ground. This pipe was subsequently used by survey number 153-78, done by Anderson Perry and Associates.

Found 3/4 inch diameter pipe as per survey number 64-78
