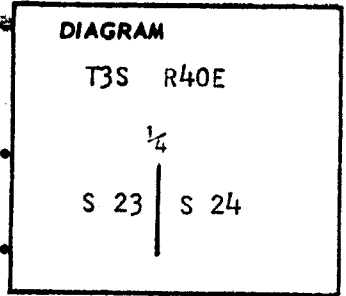


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment/ Corner originally set in 1863 by David T. Thompson, under government contract number 103. Surveyor General notes state; "Set post for 1/4 section corner from which;" A pine, 12 inches in diameter bears S 30 W, 34 links dist. A pine 24 inches in diameter bears S 3 E 500 links dist. No. subsequent record of remonumentation in survey records.



Description of corner evidence found:

Found SW. bearing tree stump, decayed, and lower blaze visible.

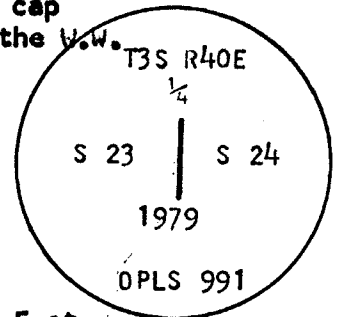
Description of monument and accessories established to perpetuate the original location of this corner

Set a 1 1/4" x 36" galvanized pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, at the called bearing and distance from the S.W. bearing tree, from which New BT'S.  
 A fir, 18 inches in diameter, bears S 75 E, 29.2 feet, marked 1/4 S 24 BT.

A pine, 20 inches in diameter, bears N 84 W, 9.2 feet, marked 1/4 S, 23 BT.

I used a steel tape and a magnetic compass with 20 degree East declination set into compass.

**CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION**

**HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:**

Corner originally established under GLO contract number 103 executed by Daniel P. Thompson, dated September 3<sup>rd</sup> 1863. Surveyor General field notes state: Set post for 1/4 sec corner from which:

- A Pine 12 in diam bears South 30° West, 34 lks dist.
- A Pine 24 in diam bears South 3° East, 500 lks dist.

In Survey Number 46-79, Gregory T. Blackman monuments the corner from original GLO evidence.

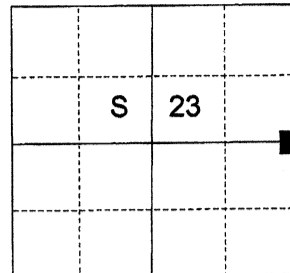
Union County monumentation records states:

Set a 1 1/4" x 36" galvanized pipe, with brass cap marked as shown, at the called bearing and distances from the S.W. bearing tree, from which New BT'S

A fir, 18 inches in diameter, bears South 75° East, 29.2 feet, marked 1/4 S 24 BT.

A pine, 20 inches in diameter, bears North 84° West, 9.2 feet, marked 1/4 S 23 BT.

**DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:**

Found a 1 1/4" iron pipe with a 2 1/2" brass cap, 6" above ground, from which:

A 20" diam. Fir stump, 2' tall, bears South 75° East, a distance of 29.20 ft., with BT scribe visible.

A 27" diam. Pine stump 18" tall bears North 84° West, a distance of 9.20 ft., with BT scribe visible.

From the iron pipe monument:

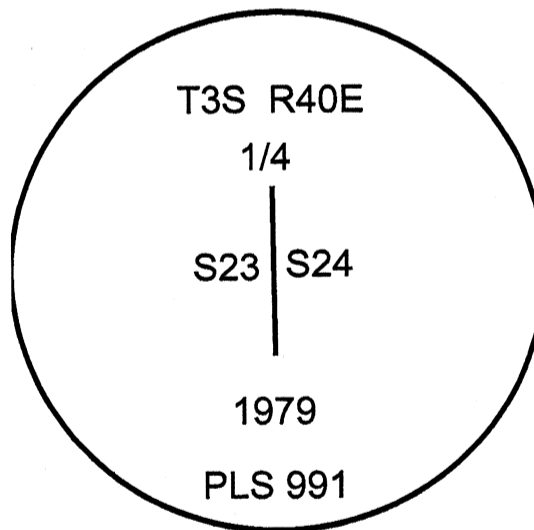
**NEW BEARING OBJECTS:**

A 22" Ponderosa Pine bears North 62° East, a distance of 12.60 ft., marked 1/4 S24 BT

A 11" Ponderosa Pine bears South 22° West, a distance of 21.45 ft., marked 1/4 S23 BT

A 10" Douglas Fir bears South 57° West, a distance of 18.45 ft., marked 1/4 S23 BT

A 4" Douglas Fir bears North 2° West, a distance of 18.00 ft., marked X BT



No trees available in the SE quadrant.



I use a tape and compass in the establishment of the new bearing objects. 14° East was used for declination and measured to a brass washer labeled "OPLS 83571" in the BT blaze at the base of the tree. Distances are to a 60D nail in the right side of the base of the center of the tree.
