

At the position determined by said survey, I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30" aluminum pipe with 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked as shown below, 28" in the ground, with ring of stone around monument, from which:

BEARING TREES:

A 17" Tamarack bears S 14°E, a distance of 35.30 feet, marked 1/4 S25 BT. A 25" Douglas Fir bears S 37°W, a distance of 46.61 feet, marked 1/4 S25 BT. A 22" Douglas Fir bears N 88°W, a distance of 7.90 feet, marked 1/4 S24 BT.

A 5" Tamarack bears N 14°W, a distance of 34.59 feet, marked X BT.
