CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

History of original corner establishment: Corner originally established by W. B. Barr under GLO Contract 355 dated June 14, 1880. Surveyor General record states:

Set a stake for the corner to sections 24, 25, 19, 30. From Which:

A 15 inch diameter Tamarack bears N 10° E, 4 1ks. A 5 inch Fir bears S 54° E, 23 1ks. A 4 inch diameter Fir bears N 10° W, 6 1ks. A 4 inch diameter fir bears S 76° W, 23 1ks.

New Bts.

Corner visited by Alonzo Geisner on GLO Contract number 683, dated June 7 1898. Surveyor General record states:

I obliterated the marks on the bearing trees in sections 19 and 30. The bearing tree in section 25 is dead and fallen down, I marked a:
A Red Fir 10 inches in diameter bears \$ 10° W, 32 1ks dist marked T3\$ R40E \$25 BT.

Description of corner evidence found: remonumentation found in county records.

Bits of wood and soil discoloration at the corner position.

A 17 inch Tamarack stump bears N 10° E, 4 1ks. Stump cut too low for scribes.

A stump hole bears \$ 54° E, 23 1ks.

A 14 inch Red Fir bears S 10 W, 32 1ks. Tree is dead and down, very rotted, could not determine scribes. A stump hole bears N 10° W, 6 1ks.

See map of survey number 30-86 filed in the office of the Union County Surveyor Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At the record bearing and distances from the bearing trees and at the point of the ground discoloration and bits of wood, I place a 21/21x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 26 inches in the ground and raised a mound of stone with a 2 foot base to top of cap, from which:

A 6'x3'x2' high rock outcrop bears \$ 78° W, 24.50 feet, marked X BO on Northerly top.

A 6 inch Douglas Fir bears N 28° W, 24.52 feet, marked X BT.

Set a steel fence post approximately 5 feet North with a 54-9 sign attached.
