

A 34" Douglas Fir bears S. 31 $1/2^{\circ}$ W., a distance of 19.62 feet, marked CS 1/16 S25 BT.



I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of the new accessories. I used 18° East declination. The distances to the accessories are from a spike set in the right hand side of the tree to the center of the aluminum cap. Bearings are from the cap to a washer marked OPLS 2219 set in the upper blaze of the tree.
