HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHED:

Corner originally established by W.B. Barr. Surveyor General notes do not record the contract number or the contract date, however the date of the oaths was July 8, 1880. Surveyor General record states:

Set Stake 4 ft long 4 in diam 18 in ground for corner to Sec 25x30x31x36 from which

Tamarack 15 in diam bears S 45° W 24 lks dist

Tamarack 15 in diam bears N 35° W 20 lks dist Fir 15 in diam bears N 12° E 20 lks dist

Pine 20 in diam bears S 73° E 29 lks dist

While performing work under GLO Contract number 683, dated June 7, 1898, Alonzo Gesner visits this corner. Surveyor General record states:

Intersected West Bdy of Township 12.80 lks S. of cor to Secs 25 + 36 Range 40 E Which is a post greatly decayed

marked and witnessed as stated by the Surveyor General. I reestablished this cor. as follows.

Set tamarack post 4 ft long 4 in. sq. 24 inches in the ground marked T3S S25 on the NW and R41E S36 on the SW faces with 1 notch S. and 5 notches on the N. edges, destroying old post and obliterating marks on the bearing trees in Secs 30 + 31, (as recorded in old survey). In 1983, Gary Langlitz brings this corner to modern standards from found original evidence. Union County Monumentation record states:

Found A Tamerac Snag 22" Dia. with visible scribing on an opened blaze "3 25" A Sawn Pine stump 26" Dia. with an axed out blaze.

A badly decayed Tamerac Stump with no visible scribing.

At the corner point determined by record bearing and distance from the three found BT's we send 2 ½" x 30" galvanized iron pipe 28" in the ground with brass cap attached. From which: A Western Larch 12" Dia. bears S19°W 37.9 ft scribed T3S R40E S36 BT

A Western Larch 10" Dia. bears N58°W 53.1 ft scribed T3S R40E S25 BT

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

Found a 2 1/2" iron pipe 3" above ground, with a 2 1/2" brass cap marked as shown below. From which:

A 15" Western Larch bears South 19° West, a distance of 37.90 feet, alive and vigorous with a healed blaze.

A 22" Western Larch Snag bears North 35° West, a distance of 13.20 feet, with scribe marks visible on open blaze.

Due to recent heavy logging activities in the area, I find no remains of the NW tree taken by Gary Langlitz, or the other original trees.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

From the iron pipe monument

NEW BEARING OBJECTS:

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears North 67° West, a distance of 20.55 feet, with a 1 1/2" aluminum cap marked UNION COUNTY SURVEYOR NW RP.




