
CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

HISTORY OF ORIGINAL CORNER ESTABLISHMENT:

Corner originally established by James W. Kimbrell in Old Book Survey Page 7, dated April 8, 1887. Survey Notes state:

Set Stone 7x9x20 ins for Center NE 1/4 Sec 31.



DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

No evidence of Kimbrell stone could be found.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED

TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At position determined by survey, I set a 5/8" x 30" iron pin, 30" in the ground, with a 2 1/2" aluminum cap, marked as shown below, in a collar of stone 1 ft. diam., from which:


A 5/8" \times 30" iron pin bears North 1°30' East, a distance of 20.00 feet, with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER N RP.

A 5/8" x 30" iron pin bears South 89°40' East, a distance of 20.00 feet, with 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " aluminum cap marked BGB SURVEY MARKER E RP.

Set a steel fence post approximately 0.5 feet North of corner monument. I hereby certify that the corner was monumented on January 26, 2015
