
## CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

## Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the

original location of this corner: At true corner position, I set a 2½x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 30 inches in the ground, from which:


A 19 inch diameter P.Pine bears \$81°E 18.63 feet marked NW1/16 \$36 BT

A 15 inch diameter Tamarack bears S46°W 8.08 feet marked NW1/16 S36 BT

Set steel fencepost approximately 5 feet North with 54-9 sign attached

Corner set October 25, 1985 Witness, Rick Robinson





I used a steel tape and magnetic compass in the establishment of these accessories. I used 20° East magnetic declination and the distances are to a 50d spike driven at the approximate center of the tree. I attached a brass washer marked OPLS 991 to the BT blaze. I painted a 6 inch red band around BTs and attached 54-3 and 54-9 signs.
