

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES I ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

At the position determined by said survey, I set a  $2 \times x \times 30$  aluminum monument marked as shown below, 20" in the ground, from which:

NEW BEARING TREES:

A 13 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears N 12°W, a distance of 35.57 ft, marked CE 1/16 S35 BT.

A 11 inch diameter Ponderosa Pine bears S  $48^{\circ}\text{E}$ , a distance of 11.03 ft, marked CE 1/16 S35 BT.

Raised a mound of stone around monument, three ft. base to top of cap.


