

A 9 inch Douglas Fir bears S 14 E, 19.27 feet, marked CW 1/16 S 36 BT, marked with a single blaze.

A 16 inch Douglas Fir bears \$ 43 W, 42.94 feet, marked X BT, on a single blaze.



original location of this corner: At the true corner position, I set a 2½'x30" aluminum pipe with aluminum cap marked as shown, 28 inches in the ground with surrounding mound of stone. From Which:


A 19 inch diameter Red Fir bears N82°E 33.54 feet marked CW 1/16 S36 BT

A 9 inch diameter Red Fir bears N22°W 30.82 feet marked CW 1/16 S36 BT
